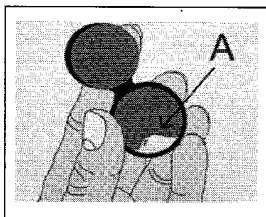

Please read these precautions thoroughly before proceeding:

- Products that go in the mouth are not returnable for any reason.
- Fangs are NOT a toy and are not intended for use by children!
- Fangs present a choking hazard, do not swallow any part of kit.
- Do not use over braces, wires, plates, crowns, dentures or ANY other dental work NOR if you have irritated or sensitive gums NOR right after a dental cleaning until your gums heal.
- For adult entertainment purposes, never bite anyone with your fangs.
- To prevent swallowing, do not eat, drink or sleep with your fangs on.
- Don't wear fangs while using drugs or alcohol. Do not smoke while customizing fangs, Customizing fluid is flammable.
- Fake blood, red wine or other foods or drinks may stain fangs.
- Blood-tips, rhinestones and color finishes on certain styles may wear or chip off with use, handle gently.
- Customize each fang separately. Enough material is provided to customize each fang twice, so you can re-adjust one if necessary.
- Replacement Customizing Kits are available from your retailer.

1. POSITION: Fangs will fit on upper or lower canines or incisors. In a mirror, find the best position for the first fang. Check the angle front-to-back & side-to-side. Practice getting it into the best position with ease so that you can locate it quickly with minimal adjustment. For the best fit, you'll want to be able to slip it up on your tooth accurately rather than putting it up and then adjusting it into place once it has the mixture inside.

2. MIX: Twist ONE capsule of powder apart and empty into the carry case if your kit includes one, or use a shot glass or metal spoon or vessel - do not use a paper or plastic cup! Tilt the carry case so that all the material is at one edge. Snap off bottle tip & squeeze 5 drops (For "shredders" use 10 drops) onto the powder. Stir with the stick provided for 20-30 seconds until the mixture is uniformly wet and turns pasty (**illustr. A**).



Illustr. A: Keep the powder/liquid mixture in a glob at the edge of the tilted carry case so you don't waste any. Scrape ALL the material into your fang cap for the best fit. Sometimes the mixture is hard to see in the black case, keep scraping it down while mixing so you get it all!

3.FIT: Scrape *all* of the mixture onto the inside walls of one fang cap, applying it to the front & back inside of the cap rather than filling up the deep cavity in the fang. (**Illustr. B**). Gently push the fang all the way up onto your tooth, attempting to locate the best position in one motion. The mixture should squeeze out around the edges of the cap into the cracks between your teeth and around your gums (for Blood-tip Fangs, do not get mixture on red tips). Also, try to push the fang lightly against the front of your tooth so it has good contact with your gumline & looks natural. **DO NOT** wiggle, adjust or reposition the fang after you push it up onto your tooth.

Apply mixture to **WALLS** of cap, not just inside the cavity. It will squeeze out when you fit them.

4.WAIT 5 MINUTES! Flare your lips and tilt your head back (so you don't drool) & watch a clock for 5 minutes as the mixture hardens. Don't start the other fang until 5 minutes have passed so that you don't accidentally loosen it before it sets up. With the first fang in place, position the next fang in the mirror. Orient the fang relative to the first so that it has a similar angle and looks good. After you've practiced putting it on accurately, follow steps 2 and 3 again. Keep in mind that mouths & teeth are asymmetrical and fangs may not fit your right and left teeth exactly the same, this is natural. You are trying to get the *best fit* for each tooth.

5. REMOVE: To prevent the fangs from getting stuck on your teeth, remove them to "break the seal" right after you complete the customizing process on both fangs, then you can then put them back on. Gently push your lower teeth forward against the backside of the fang tips until you hear a slight click (**Illustr. C**). Then wiggle and pull gently with your fingers until they loosen up. Your fangs will now clip on and off easily, yet fit snug.

It takes a minute to wiggle them off, take your time and grab around the gumline so you don't pull the cap off the liner.

TIP #1: These fangs fit "most" people perfectly with one fitting and they have a long track-record of safe & long-lasting wear. But, sometimes teeth are particularly small, smooth or pointed. If your fangs are well-positioned but you want them tighter, use only one capsule to re-customize over the existing liner for *both* fangs (follow #5).

TIP #2: The liner is transparent so that it won't show when it squeezes out around the edges and over the back of the cap. This helps the mold adhere to the fang cap itself so it won't pull out, so do not trim that off. The more excess you leave on after it's finished, the better the fit. If you want to trim, do so carefully with a nail clipper. Only trim the excess that shows on the front of the fang rather than between teeth or on the back.

TIP #3: If the mold pulls out of the fang cap, but still fits over your tooth really well, you can put a tiny drop of crazy glue between the liner & fang cap to adhere them together. Don't get the crazy glue on your tooth!
